## Is Your Fleet Running — Or Just Not Broken Yet?

Rate your fleet across five critical areas. Each section reveals a different vulnerability.

### HOW TO USE THIS:

Score each item 0, 1, or 2. 0 = Not in place 1 = Partially done 2 = Consistently done

Total each section. Lower scores = higher risk of expensive downtime.

### PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE

#### PM Scheduling

Each truck has a written maintenance schedule based on mileage or time intervals.

#### Service Records

You keep a log of every oil change, inspection, and repair per vehicle.

Drivers check fluids, tire pressure, and lights before every shift.

### INSPECTION HABITS
